This replaces the old parish council website hosted for free by the County Council – a service which is coming to an end as Devolution progresses. The old website will remain in place until all bugs have been ironed out.

Our new website also offers a shortcut to quickly access the most recent planning applications in the parish (subject to a 48 hour delay after the district council first publishes). The aim is to make it easier for residents to access planning details without knowing/searching for the application number allocated by the district council. (All planning details are still fully accessible direct from the Malvern Hills District Council website site if residents choose. The district council remains responsible for all planning application information published).

Recent project updates...

- Some of the ditches have been cleared at Monkwood Green to try to control winter standing water.
- The ditches at Sinton Green village green will be cleared out asap now that the warmer weather is coming.
- The parish council continues to gladly cooperate and provide access for the Worcestershire Wildlife Trust who are improving cattle trough provision at Monk Wood.
- Worcestershire County Council have been in touch about the bus shelters and bus services in the parish and the parish council looks forward to hearing what they have to say about preserving bus services for the parish.
- Thank you to Councillor Probert for replacing and caring for the event Oak Trees around the parish and to the Peace Hall for assisting.
- Maintenance has taken place on the defibrillator at Grimley Village – all are available for use by the public once an emergency call to 999 has been made and instructions have been received from the operator.
