September's parish council meeting saw the co-option of two new councillors, Simon and Matthew. We are really pleased to have them on board and look forward to having them working with us.

Extracts from September parish council minutes

- Urgent parish council follow up with Highways regarding the water running down Dark Lane and Walton Lane. Recent roadworks have only solved one of the three identified water 'sources'.
- Dark Lane has been added to the Highways winter grit routes at the request of parish councillors and residents. Walton Lane also remains on that grit route thankfully.
- Worlds End roadside ditches have been cleared by the landowners and contractors. The parish council would like to extend sincere thanks for these works to address local property flooding.
- The Clerk was instructed to request Highways clearance of pipes/drains in vicinity of the Open Ditch pub in order to address the water running down the road from Oakhall Green to Sinton Green.
- The parish council endeavours to find the cause of Monkwood Green road flooding adjacent to Goodwin's Farm.
- The parish council will approach residents at Moseley to talk about ongoing, long term road flooding and possible ditch works by landowners.
- Residents have applied to conduct repairs to the parish council owned service roads at Monkwood Green the parish council has agreed and will assist as required.
- The Worcestershire Wildlife Trust has donated a new cattle trough for Monkwood Green Common and the parish council has proceeded to apply for a new water connection from Severn Trent.
- Five year rolling ditch maintenance on Monkwood Green will be pursued.
- The parish council continues to await a contracted engineer from the Heart Beat Trust to repair the defibrillator at Monkwood Green.
- Sinton Green village green ditch clearance works will be undertaken by a local contractor asap.
- Correspondence will be sent to residents with residential hedges encroaching parish council land.
- The parish council continues to explore options for allotment provision in the parish.
- The fallen tree along the tow path has been reported to Highways after the River Canal Trust declined responsibility.
- Landowners down Camp Lane are to be reminded to undertake regular care of the road side hedgerows please.
